Zug, February 23, 2015 - The Bossard Group has completed the acquisition of the fastening solutions division of Forind Avio Elettronica S.p.a., announced on January 12, 2015. The acquisition, which will be fully implemented with effect as of February 23, consolidates Bossard's position in the Italian market. The acquired division generates an annual turnover of approximately CHF 5 million and employs 10 people. The parties have agreed to keep the acquisition price confidential.

After its inception in 1968, the company, domiciled in Cassina de' Pecchi near Milan, became primarily known as a supplier to the challenging aerospace industry.
